New JDN Air Hoists Mini 'food grade' design

For the food industry, chemical and pharmaceutical companies

In the food and beverage industry, and also for chemical and pharmaceutical companies, special demands are made in terms of cleanliness and hygiene. To meet the requirements of these industries, J.D. Neuhaus GmbH & Co. KG (JDN) is now introducing a 'food grade' version of the air hoists in the mini series. The motor housing is made of uncoated cast aluminium. The chain, chain guide, load sleeve and hooks are made from stainless steel. This makes the hoists corrosion resistant and impervious to high humidity. In addition, the hoists are easy to clean: even a high-pressure washer can be used without problem. JDN is using compressed air as an energy medium. Due to this no electrical short cut can happen. Additionally the hoists can be used, for example, in areas containing flammable organic substances. A completely synthetic (mineral oil-free) special grease that poses no physiological risk is used for lubrication of the motor, which is particularly well-suited to the food and pharmaceutical industries. The lubricant for the chain is also food-grade approved. The hoists' top hooks and load hooks are twist lock hooks. This enhances safety in daily operation. The hoists are available with a lifting height of 5 metres and a control length of 4 metres.

Company information

At its Witten plant, J.D. Neuhaus GmbH & Co. KG, which employs more than 200 people across the group, produces pneumatically and hydraulically-operated



hoists and crane systems. Thanks to this globally unique specialisation, J.D. Neuhaus not only sets the quality standard in this field, but, with customers in over 90 countries, they are also the world market leaders. Their products are utilised in the chemical industry, in foundries and in the food industry, among others, as well as in many other areas of logistics. In total, J.D. Neuhaus supplies around 70 industries.

Production takes place exclusively on site in Witten. Services such as assembly, inspection, maintenance and a general overhaul of systems, as well as customer training sessions, round off the broad product range on offer.

Sales and distribution activities are handled by JDN sales companies in France, Great Britain, Singapore and the USA, in cooperation with international partners, forming a comprehensive, worldwide network. The company's export share is over 80%.

The company was founded in 1745 and is still owned by the founder family today, in its seventh generation. This year the company is celebrating its 275th anniversary.
